
A global community

A-Level

British A-Levels are globally recognised as the gold standard in education, preparing students for universities worldwide. We use your university and career aspirations to match you to the right programme of study.

We are in the top 1% of 4,404 schools and colleges in England for progress at A-Level, or Value Added. This means that, on average, our students make more progress at A-Level than their peers, despite starting with similar GCSE results.

Flexible programme options

Two-Year A-Level A traditional A-Level programme over the course of two years.

Five-Term A-Level Starting in January, the content of the first year of the two-year A-Level is taught in an accelerated six-month course. Perfect for students who want to switch schools after the academic year has started, or for international students whose academic year starts in January.



Our BTEC Business programme is suited to those who want a more practical learning experience. It can be taken either alongside or instead of A-Levels.

Flexible course options

The BTEC Business Level 3 Diploma is a qualification that offers an introduction to the core areas of business. We offer a number of flexible course options:

Level 3 Diploma 8-units and taken over one year. This is equal to 2 A-Levels.

Equal to 3 A-Levels.

Level 3 Extended Diploma 13 units and taken over two years or five terms.

BTEC Plus Level 3 Diploma + A-Level subject, usually over the course of one year.

One-Year GCSE

Our intensive GCSE programme offers focused preparation for A-Level or BTEC study.

This course provides an excellent opportunity to prepare for A-Level study, retake exams to improve existing GCSE grades, or study extra subjects. Most universities now require you to demonstrate proficiency in Maths and English, with a minimum of Grade 5 in these subjects; some degrees may require other GCSE subjects in addition.

To be accepted onto the GCSE programme, you must be sure you can cope with an intensive one year course of study in 5 to 7 GCSE subjects.
